#### C. WORKSHOP SESSION

School board Evaluating and Improving Student Outcomes (EISO) required training

Dr. Christi Morgan, Assistant Superintendent for Sunnyvale ISD, came to provide required EISO board training which includes goal evaluation and goal setting. The group reviewed the CSISD Framework for Success and how it ties to student outcomes and successes, relationships with students, staff and the community, accountability to stakeholders and to the State through testing. Discussion of College, Career and Military readiness measures, state and district test scores, student achievement, school progress and closing the gaps.

Stormy Hickman, Executive Director of Elementary Education, reviewed the HB 3 required goals and objectives aligned with the CSISD Strategic Plan. The targets were set pre-COVID and we are currently exceeding the State. Review of where we are on our own goal progress measures. Then the group looked at the proposed updated new district goals for five years out. Following this meeting, administration will work with campuses to do the same. We want to make it clearer and more understandable. We will bring these goals back, possibly in December, for consideration of approval by the Board.
