A. CALL TO ORDER

c. HEARING OF CITIZENS

D. WORKSHOP SESSION

1. Science Update

Amanda Gibson, Coordinator of Science Instruction, <u>reviewed</u> the science comparison MAP data in the district from fall to winter. She then reviewed where science instruction is headed in the next couple of years as well. Discussion occurred.

2. Construction Update

Josh Symank, Deputy Superintendent for Operations, gave an <u>update</u> on construction projects across the district upcoming for the summer. Numerous projects will be done at A&M Consolidated High School starting with roofing in March and April to finish by summer of 2026. The GMP for the project at Consol is on the agenda for the board meeting later this evening. The GMP for CSHS expansion and Rock Prairie remodel will be on the agenda later this evening as well. Discussion occurred.

3. Demographer Update

Heather Wilson, Chief Financial Officer, introduced Paul Cash of Zonda Demographics. Mr. Cash provided an <u>update</u> on demographics in CSISD including median age, unemployment, housing trends, housing prices, and numbers of single and multi family residences. Also reviewed were the student demographics for CSISD which includes birthrates, kindergarten projections, and enrollment trends by cohort of students. Discussion occurred. There are capacity concerns at the following campuses: Southwood Valley, Pebble Creek, Spring Creek, Pecan Trail, and Wellborn Middle School. We will come back to this in June and discuss rezoning plans which are anticipated for discussion and possible approval in November.
