Teacher Requested Resources - searchable and browsable collection of resources collected at the request of Texas Middle School Teachers.

Teacher Workshops - provides technology (Microsoft PowerPoint) instruction and integration of environmental health science into science and non-science classes.

NSF Fellows Program - a GK-12 program to train Graduate and Undergraduates and improve the content of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) in rural grades 6-8.

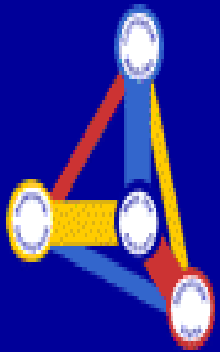

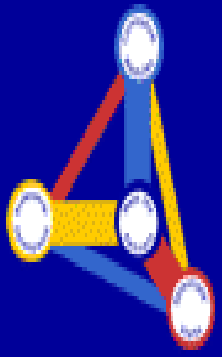

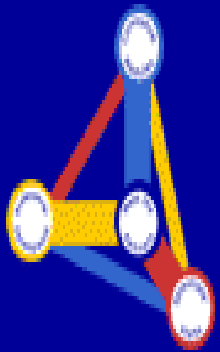
GK-12 Programs are sponsored by the National Science Foundation. There are currently 12 of these programs at Universities in Texas and over 100 nationwide.

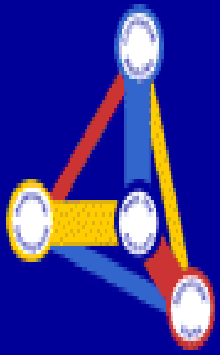
