Subject: Consider approval of an Interlocal Agreement between the Brazos County Health Department ("Department"), and College Station Independent School District (the "District") covering the use of district facilities for mass immunizations or treatment in the case of a public health emergency

BACKGROUND

College Station ISD is an active partner with Brazos County, the cities of Bryan and College Station and other agencies in responding to community emergencies. CSISD campuses have served as shelters for local and out-of-town evacuees during hurricanes and a chemical fire, and we work with these agencies regularly to plan for other emergencies.


In November 2005, CSISD entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the Brazos County Health Department to open our facilities for the department's use in public health emergencies that require either mass immunization or mass treatment. To be activated, the Commissioner of Health or the Brazos County Health Authority must declare that large scale immunization or treatment is necessary, and classes at the district facilities must be not in session or canceled.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District approve the Interlocal Agreement with the Brazos County Health Department for mass immunization and treatment in the case of a public health emergency.
