

SELECTION OF HEAD START POLICY COUNCIL MEMBERS

The College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees, serving as the Grantee for the Head Start program, has determined the selection of membership in the Head Start Policy Council shall take place in this manner:

1. Each campus shall have an annual Orientation Program mandated for all enrolled parents to attend. This meeting will focus on general Head Start information and specific campus details to foster the success of the child and family during their Head Start experience.
2. A part of the agenda will address the roles of the Policy Council and the Campus Committee and the responsibilities and opportunities for parents to participate in these groups.
3. During this session, parents will be invited to become involved and to determine if they would like to volunteer to serve on the Policy Council. Names of parents interested in contributing to the Policy Council by serving faithfully will be taken. Details of the service and the responsibilities will be discussed with the parents both during this meeting and in subsequent meetings with Family Services Facilitators. Election of these parents to serve on Policy Council by the parents of Head Start children will be held in one of two ways:
 - a. at this session or
 - b. at the program wide Family Celebration held in September.
4. Community Representatives will be selected by the sitting Policy Council. Names of suggested community members or suitable organizations will be discussed by the second monthly Policy Council meeting. At that time, members will be assigned suggested names to contact and will bring the information to either Head Start administrative staff or to the next Policy Council meeting. Community members who have agreed to serve will be added to the roster as soon as possible.
