

Subject: Proposed Breakfast Price Reduction for Students Eligible for Reduced Price Meals

BACKGROUND


The current price for breakfast charged to students eligible for reduced-price meals is \$0.30. The proposed change would reduce that price to \$0.10.

The proposed price reduction would likely increase participation in the breakfast program, thereby enabling more students to begin the school day after having a nutritious breakfast.

Increased participation from students eligible for reduced-price meals would also result in additional meal reimbursements through the National School Breakfast Program.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District consider approval of the reduction in the price of breakfast from \$0.30 to \$0.10 for students eligible for reduced-price meals for the 2006-2007 school year.
