

**ORDER CALLING A BOND ELECTION**

**THE STATE OF TEXAS** §  
**COUNTY OF BRAZOS** §  
**COLLEGE STATION INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT** §

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees deems it advisable to call the bond election hereinafter ordered; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all is required by Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COLLEGE STATION INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:**

1. That joint elections are to be held by the City of College Station, Texas and the College Station Independent School District to be conducted by the City of College Station, Texas on May 12, 2007 between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. in said District, and a bond election for the District shall be held on that date, at the regular election precincts of said District at the polling places shown below:

2. That the City, on behalf of the District, shall appoint all election officials.
3. That joint early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance and by mail. The period for early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be April 30, 2007 through May 8, 2007. Optical scan ballots shall be used for early voting by mail and direct recording electronic voting machines shall be used for early voting by personal appearance. The Joint Early Voting Clerk for said elections shall be the City Secretary. She shall determine the number of election workers to hire and arrange for training of all election workers and assign to three early voting locations. The Election Coordinator for the District shall serve as Regular Early Voting Clerk in said election. The main early voting polling places by personal appearance shall be as follows:

City Hall, 1101 Texas Avenue, College Station, Texas.

Two branch early voting locations shall be designated for these election.

4. That all resident, qualified electors of said District shall be entitled to vote at said election.
5. That the substantial copy of the Order shall serve as proper Notice of said election, and the President of the Board of Trustees shall cause said Notice to be published one time, not earlier than the 30<sup>th</sup> day or later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day to the date set for the election, in a newspaper published in said District or, if none is published in said District, in a newspaper of general circulation in said District. In addition, not later than the 21<sup>st</sup> day prior to the date set for the election, the President of the Board of Trustees shall cause said Notice to be posted on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the Board of Trustees.
6. That at said election the following **PROPOSITION** shall be submitted in accordance with the law:

### **PROPOSITION**

Shall the Board of Trustees of said District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$67,420,000, for the purpose of the construction and equipment of school buildings in the District and the purchase of the necessary sites therefor, with said bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of

Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds?

8. That the official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION with the ballots to contain such provision, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:

9. In accordance with Section 123.001 of the Texas Election Code, the Hart Intercivic Direct Recording Electronic Voting System, Optical Scan Voting System and Electronic Management System for Brazos County, Texas is hereby adopted for the general and special election.

10. In all respects, the election shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code.
