

2007-08 District Improvement Plan Goals and Objectives

- 1. All Students Will Achieve Academic Success**
 - a. In all tested grade levels and subject areas each African American, Hispanic and economically disadvantaged student group will exceed the state average on TAKS tests.**
 - b. All students will pass the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills in 2006-2007.**
 - c. The district will provide higher education and career/technology education preparation and awareness for all students.**
 - d. Student TAKS performance will reflect a reduced achievement gap.**
 - e. Commended performance will exceed the State average.**

- 2. Educational Opportunities Will Meet the Unique Academic, Social and Emotional Needs Of All Students.**
 - a. The percentage of African American, Hispanic, and economically disadvantaged students enrolled in advanced classes will be representative of the CSISD school population.**
 - b. Students nominated as Gifted and Talented will be representative of the CSISD student population.**
 - c. Students identified for special education will be representative of the CSISD student population**
 - d. A Coordinated School Health Program will be implemented by child nutrition services, physical education teachers, classroom teachers, and nurses.**

- 3. Educational Practices Will Be Predicated on Scientifically Based Research**
 - a. Opportunities for dialogue and discussion will be created among all CSISD employees regarding the role that relationships, expectations and school culture play in student performance and behavior.**
 - b. Curriculum maps will be used to identify gaps and redundancies in the curriculum.**
 - c. Instructional strategies will be used so that students are engaged in learning at all levels.**

- 4. Parents and Community Members Will Be Actively Engaged.**
 - a. Parental involvement will be representative of the CSISD student population.**
 - b. Training and resources for parents and volunteers will be provided at all schools/campuses.**
 - c. Parents will be informed of career and higher education opportunities for their children.**
 - d. Community members will be used as a resource for educational opportunities**

- 5. A Safe and Supportive Environment Will Be Provided For All Students.**
 - a. Each campus will comply with the District Crisis Management Plan**
 - b. Procedures for management of student behavior will be consistent across the district.**
