## BACKGROUND

The Ford Motor Company has discontinued the production of Ford Freestar vans. The Board had previously authorized the purchase of these vans.

After exploring the market through a bid process, it appears that the best value to the District in acquiring similar vans is through a contract available through the Texas Building and Procurement Commission (TBPC).

Two passenger vans for the Transportation Department and three cargo vans for the Technology Department are available through the TBPC contract at a total cost of \$77,256.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District consider authorization of the purchase of vehicles through a Contract administered by the State of Texas Building and Procurement Commission for a total price of \$77,256.
