Background

The adoption of textbooks is an annual process instituted by the Texas Education Agency on a cycle for each of the content areas taught in our schools. The 2004-2005 adoption cycle focused on many content areas including Business Education. Accounting (part of the Business Education adoption) was not being offered at the high school at that time.

For the 2007-2008 school year, one class of Accounting will be offered at A&M Consolidated High School. Therefore, an Accounting textbook needs to be requested from TEA by the District. Dianne Rister, teacher for the course, reviewed texts and materials from the two companies that are currently on the approved TEA list for this textbook, talked with teachers from other districts using both adoptions, and discussed her recommendations with Judy McLeod, Director for Career and Technology.
