

## BACKGROUND

The College Station ISD Purchasing Department has evaluated the proposed purchase of Web Filter Software through the Catalog Information Services Vendor program for compliance with sound business practice and with State procurement statutes. The recommended purchase appears to be in compliance with both.

The cost of this proposed purchase is to be paid from funds within the previously approved General Fund budget.

The personnel evaluating this proposed purchase included Mark Pantel, Coordinator of Purchasing, and Keith Slaughter, Network Manager. They have recommended that the purchase be made through the CISV program from PC Hotline, Inc. for a total price of \$45,192.30. Their recommendation is provided in the accompanying memo dated June 12, 2007 from Mark Pantel and Keith Slaughter.
