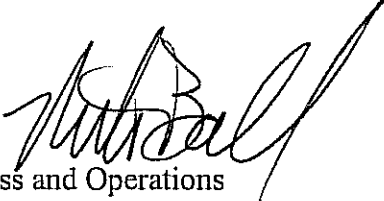

The College Station ISD Purchasing Department in cooperation with Curriculum and Instruction personnel has solicited bids for library books.

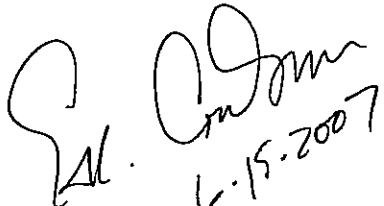
