

BACKGROUND

Requests for Competitive Sealed Proposals for the District's student athletic and extra-curricular insurance coverage were distributed to the public earlier during the summer.

Three respondents have provided proposals. .

The proposal from Brazos Valley Insurance includes a provision for full assignment through a Preferred Provider Organization. The full assignment through a PPO group provides students and their parents the opportunity to receive treatment from various local health care providers that have contracted to accept the coverage. The contracted health care providers will not bill the students for more than the benefits provided in the policy.

Brazos Valley Insurance Group has provided the response that meets the specifications in the Request For Competitive Sealed Proposals. Their proposal appears to provide the best value both to the district and also to the students participating in the extra-curricular activities.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District consider approval of the proposal from Brazos Valley Insurance Group for Student Athletic and Extra-curricular Insurance for the 2007-2008 fiscal year.
