

SUBJECT: Science Materials for College Station High School

As part of the 2009 bond program, the staff at College Station High School worked to identify the classroom science materials needed at College Station High School. Request for Bids (RFB) #12-005- Science Materials for College Station High School were mailed January 9, 2012 to twelve vendors, advertised January 9 and January 16, 2012 and posted on the CSISD website. Twelve vendors responded to the Request for Bids which opened January 31, 2012.



After reviewing and evaluating the bids and seeking input from the staff within the Science Department at College Station High School, it appears that Sargent Welch submitted the lowest responsible bid for the science materials specified in this RFB.

It is the recommendation of Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing and Mike Martindale, Principal College Station High School to purchase the science materials for College Station High School from Sargent Welch for a total not to exceed \$113,241.60.
