Background

Administrators at SHSU have asked me to consider teaching an on-line class at Sam Houston State University during the spring 2008 semester. According to my contract, before I accept outside employment the board must consent to such employment. Specifically, my contract states in III (b):

Outside Activities: The Superintendent agrees to devote his time, skill, labor, and attention to performing his duties, but may, with prior written consent of the Board, undertake consulting work, teaching, speaking engagements, writing, lecturing, and other professional duties and obligations that do not conflict or interfere with the Superintendent's professional responsibilities to the District.

My obligations to CSISD will not be negatively impacted if such a teaching opportunity is approved by the CSISD Board. In fact, the opportunity to work with other professionals, glean new ideas from others and the experience of teaching in an on-line environment should be a positive impact to the district.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the CSISD School Board consent to allow Eddie Coulson to teach at SHSU during the spring 2008 semester.
