

## Interlocal Agreement – Fueling Facilities

### Agenda Item:

Consider approval of an Interlocal Agreement between Texas A&M University (“**TAMU**”), the City of College Station (“**City**”) and College Station Independent School District (“**CSISD**”) for the shared use of reserved fuel in emergency situations.

### Motion and Resolution

On motion made and seconded, it is hereby resolved that:

- A. **WHEREAS**, Chapter 791 of the TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, also known as the INTERLOCAL COOPERATION ACT, authorizes all local government entities to contract with each other to provide a governmental function or service that each party to the contract is authorized to perform individually and in which the contracting parties are mutually interested; and
- B. **WHEREAS**, College Station Independent School District (“**CSISD**”), the City of College Station (“**City**”) and Texas A&M University (“**TAMU**”) are local government entities, each acting by and through their duly authorized agents (collectively, the “**Parties**”); and
- C. **WHEREAS**, College Station, CSISD, and TAMU have fuel reserves for their respective fleets of vehicles; and
- D. **WHEREAS**, the sources of fuel are vulnerable to forces outside the control of any of the Parties to this ILA; and
- E. **WHEREAS**, these sources and/or fuel reserves could be disrupted and negatively affect the Parties ability to maintain normal or emergency operations; and
- F. **WHEREAS**, College Station, CSISD and TAMU have reserves of fuel that could, for a reasonable period of time, be shared with the other Parties; and
- G. **WHEREAS**, TAMU has presented the Board of Trustees of CSISD (“**Board**”) with a proposed Interlocal Agreement (the “**ILA**”), attached hereto as **Exhibit “1,”** by and between Texas A&M University, the City and CSISD, under which TAMU the parties will agree to share the reserves of fuel with one another in a time of need for a reasonable period of time; and
- H. **WHEREAS**, the ILA provides that a Party who receives fuel under this agreement will reimburse the party from which it receives fuel for the cost of the fuel; and
- I. **WHEREAS** College Station, CSISD and TAMU agree this ILA would mutually benefit each Party in a time of need for fuel and would further their governmental purpose; and
- J. **WHEREAS**, CSISD, pursuant to the authority granted under Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code desires to participate in the described agreement offered by TAMU, and is of the opinion that participation will benefit the school district, and the community.

ON MOTION, DULLY MADE AND SECONDED IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

1. The terms and conditions of the ILA, and any other documents necessary to effectuate the ILA, have been received by the Board of Trustees of CSISD and found to be acceptable and in the best interest of CSISD and its citizens, and are hereby in all things approved.
2. The Board further resolves that the ILA as approved by this resolution is in conformity with the Texas Government Code, including provisions of Chapter 771 et. seq., and Chapter 791, et. seq.
3. The Board further authorizes the Board President and her agents and assigns to execute this ILA and any other documents necessary to effectuate the ILA.
