Background

The attached memorandum from Mr. Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and Mr. Hector Silva, Director of Transportation, includes the recommendation to purchase a forty-seven (47) passenger bus with air conditioning and lift. School buses are available through the Houston Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Purchasing Cooperative and College Station ISD is a purchasing member of this cooperative. This purchase will be paid for with funds allocated by the CSISD Special Services Department.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District consider approval of the purchase of one IC Corporation Navistar forty-seven (47) passenger special needs bus in the amount of \$94,155.00, from Longhorn Bus Sales, through the HGAC.
