BACKGROUND

The 82nd Texas Legislature created an instructional materials allotment for the purchase of instructional materials, technological equipment and technology-related services. This new allotment has created a significant change in the traditional public school methodology for obtaining such items as textbooks and computers. This new legislation also transfers ownership of instructional materials from the state to the local district.
