

BACKGROUND


The 2011-2012 school year is the first year for the transition from the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) test to the new State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR). Students in grades 3-8 took these first STAAR tests in the spring of 2012. The Texas Education Agency did not determine the passing standards for STAAR in grades 3-8 until late fall 2012, and districts did not receive their results until January 2013.

RECOMMENDATION – REPORT ONLY

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station ISD receive a report summarizing the preliminary results on the 2012 STAAR tests for students who were in grades 3-8 last school year.
