BACKGROUND

Request for Bid (RFB) #14-011, Plumbing Labor Bid was advertised according to state law, local policy and standard practices. This labor will be used to supplement normal CSISD Facilities department personnel as needed. Four vendors responded to the RFB and submitted hourly rates quotes as requested in the bid documents. Two vendors were selected based on their scores on the evaluation matrix. Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and Jon Hall, Executive Director of Facilities recommend that the bid be awarded to Ed Phillips Plumbing and Brazos Valley Sewer Drain Service.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station ISD Board of Trustees award RFB #14-011 Plumbing Labor Bid to Ed Phillips Plumbing and Brazos Valley Sewer Drain Service for a term of twelve months with an option to renew for two additional years.
