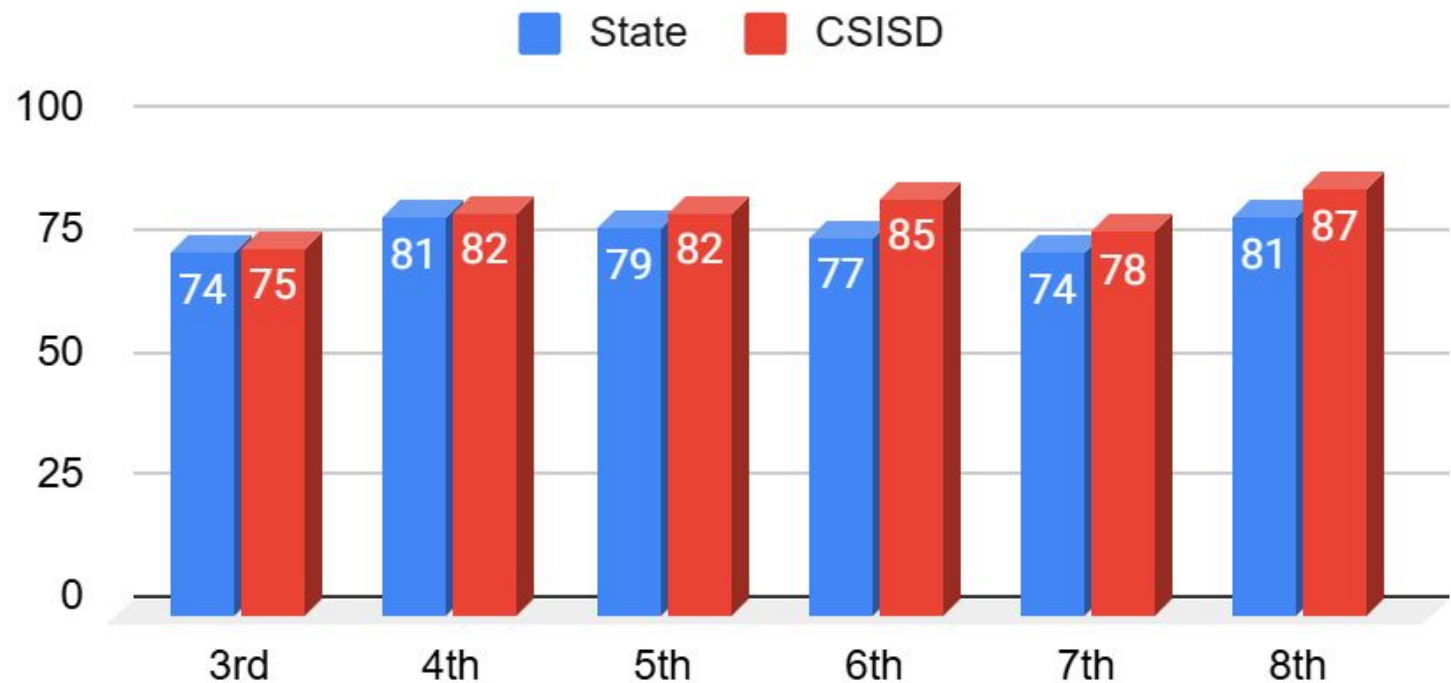

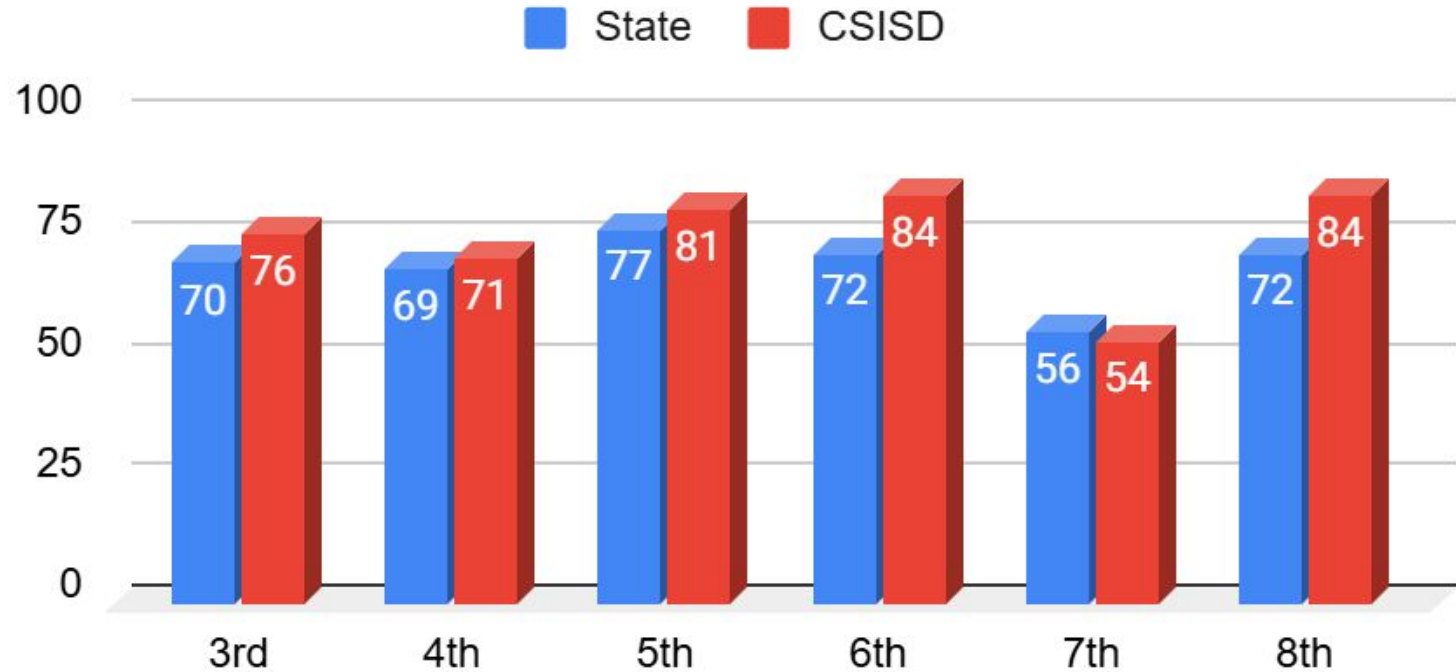
2024 STAAR Grades 3-8 Reading

2024 STAAR Grades 3-8 Mathematics

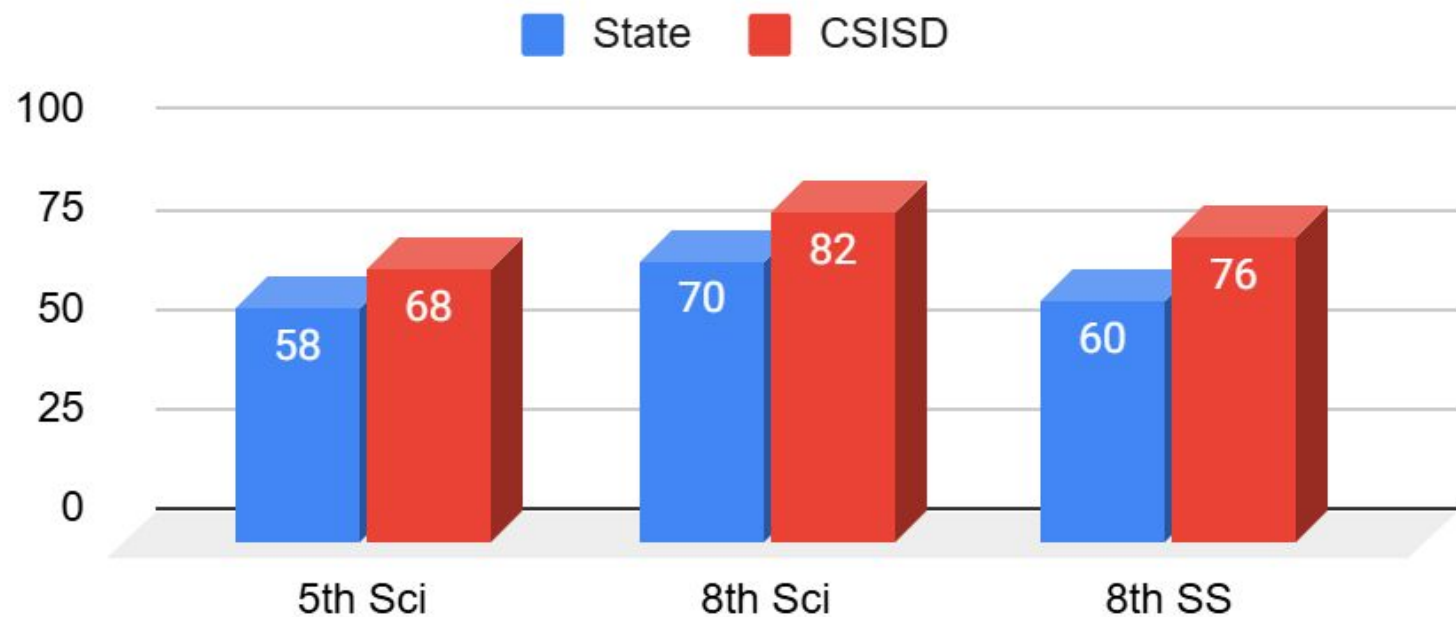

67% of 8th grade students took the on-level grade 8 math exam

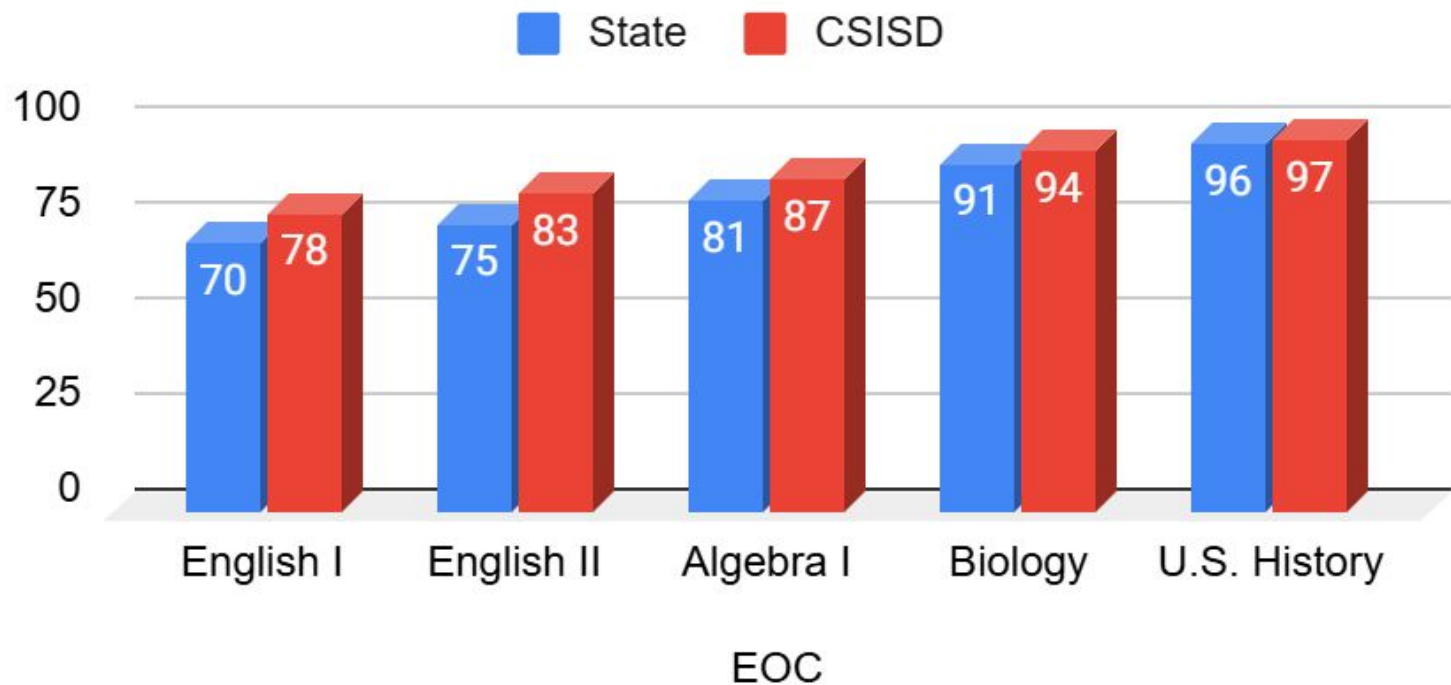

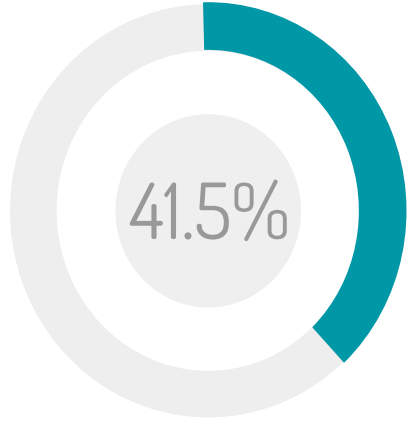

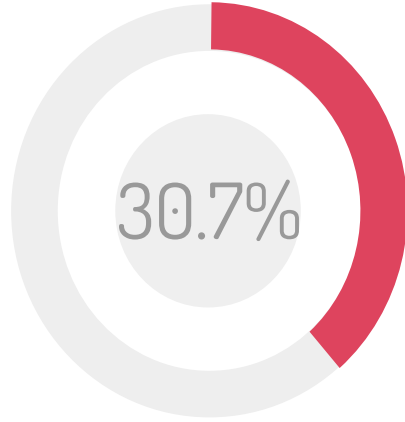

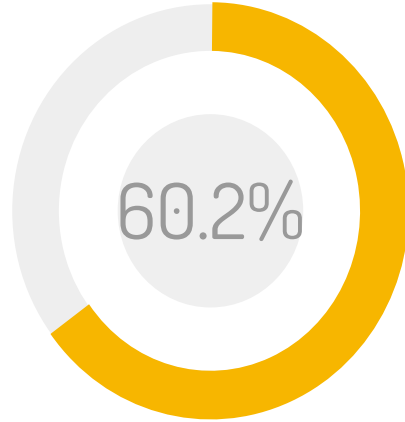

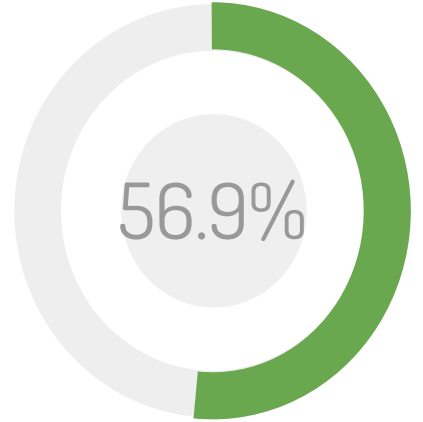

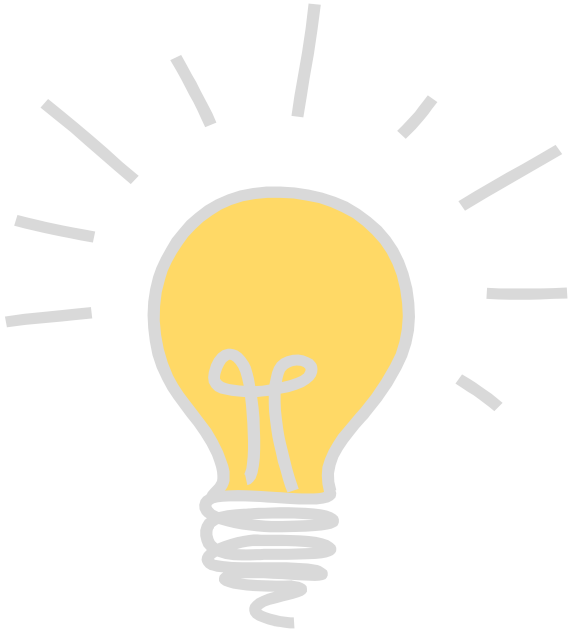

Advanced Placement



Across all subjects, **30.7%** of 11th & 12th grade students **participated** in AP exams in at least one subject. (*State = 24.2%*)



Participation rates in Social Studies (17.1%) were highest, then Math (16.1%), ELA (15.6%) and Science (13.9%)



CSISD students taking AP exams perform exceptionally well relative to their peers across the state: **81.5% of students met criterion** in all subjects (*state rate = 53.3%*)

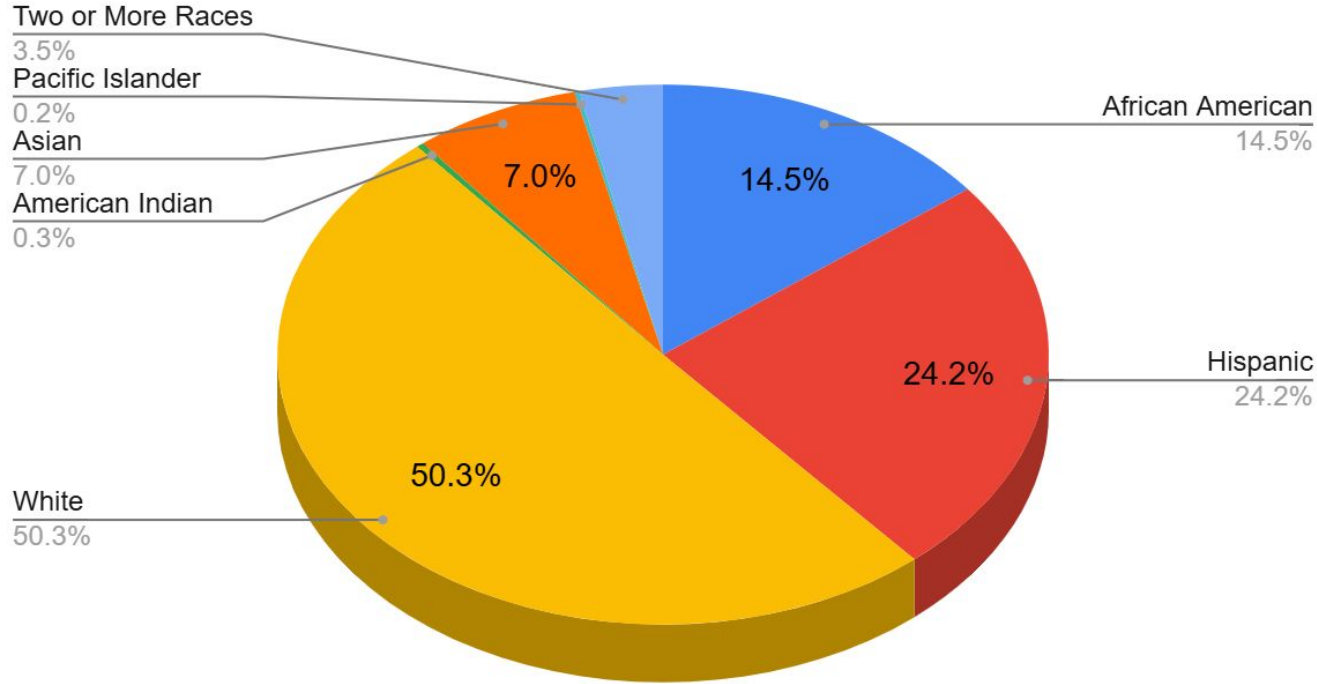

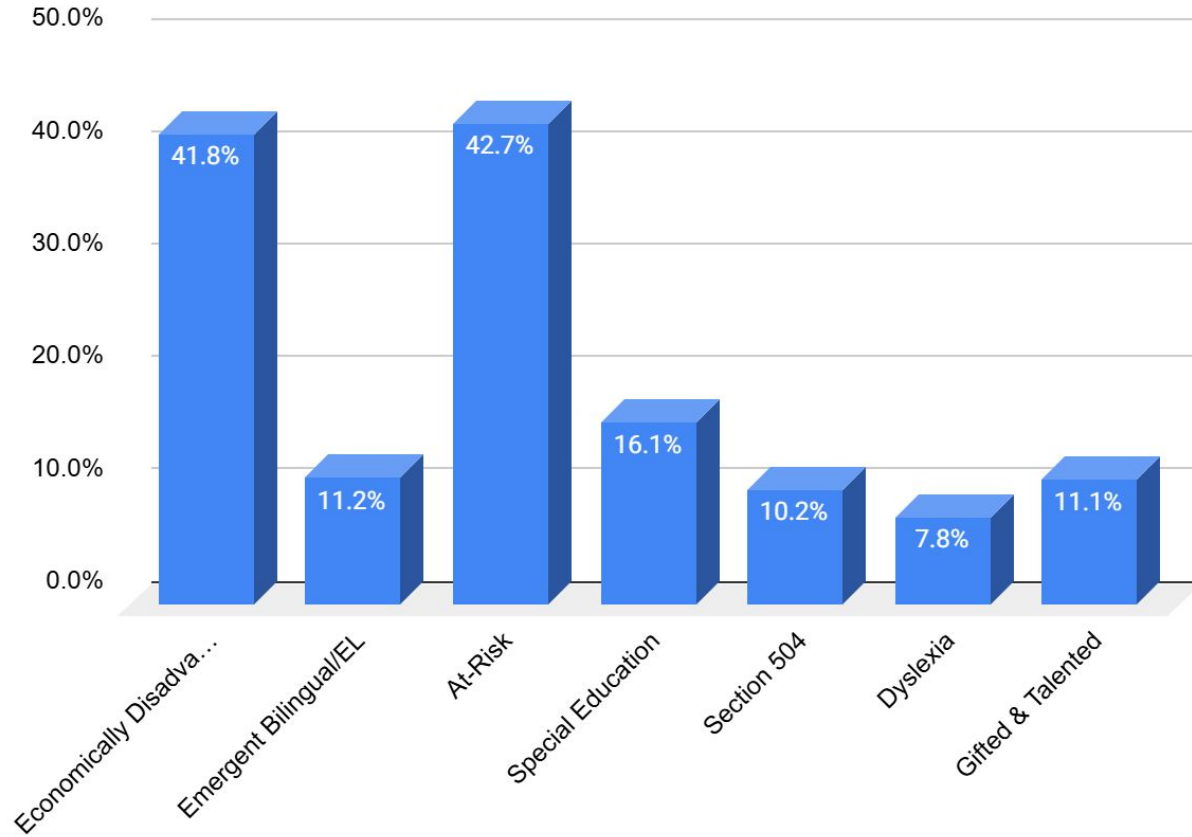

2023-24 Students by Ethnicity

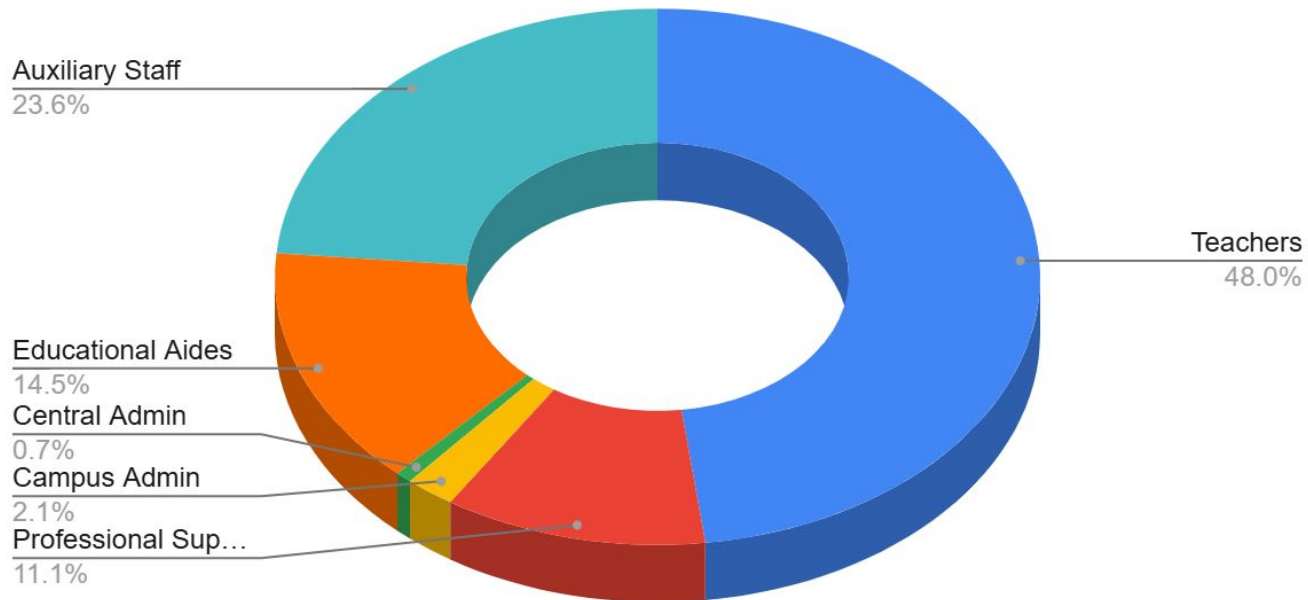


2023-24 Special Populations

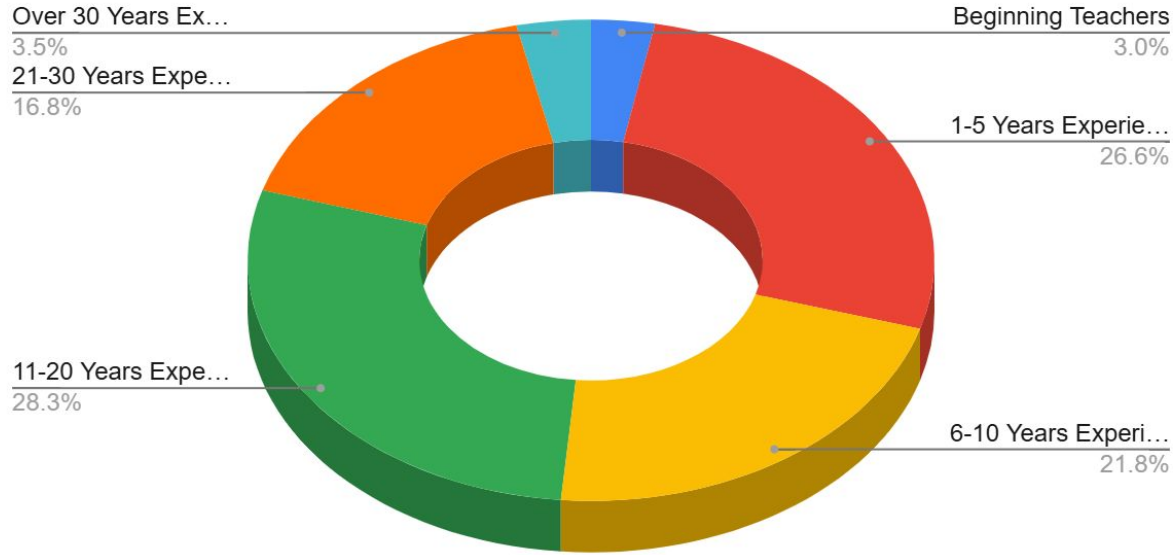

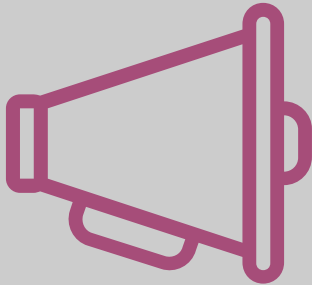
