Heinemann is the sole source provider of all products and programs offered in their sales catalogs.

Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and Stormy Hickman, Spring Creek Elementary Principal have evaluated this quote and determined that it will fulfill the needs of the campus. This purchase is part of the 2013 Bond Program.
