BACKGROUND

The Brazos County Tax Assessor/Collector has provided the district with its 2015 tax roll information. The Texas Property Tax Code requires the assessor to enter the amount of tax determined in the appraisal roll and submit it to the governing body of the unit for approval. The appraisal roll with amounts of tax entered as approved by the governing body constitutes the unit's tax roll.

The attached memo and reports from the Tax Assessor/Collector explains the methodology used in calculating the tax roll. By legislative requirement the total certified values are calculated including the additional Homestead Exemption of \$10,000 before the results of the November 3, 2015 election to approve or disapprove this additional exemption.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station ISD Board of Trustees consider approval of the attached 2015 tax roll totals pursuant to the Texas Property Tax Code.
