Background

The 2013 Bond Package Deferred Maintenance Budget includes funding for roof coating at College Station Middle School.

A proposal was requested from Hi-Mark Waterproofing, an approved vendor on the Choice Partners Purchasing Cooperative. All items on this cooperative have been competitively bid based on state statutes. The proposal was evaluated by Jon Hall, Executive Director of Facilities, and Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing. This proposal appears to provide the best value to the district in an amount not to exceed \$303,857.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District consider approval of the proposal from Hi-Mark Waterproofing for roof coating at College Station Middle School in an amount not to exceed \$303,857.
