SUBJECT: Mizuni Data Warehouse and Dashboard Suite

A committee was formed back in October 2015 to look at several different vendors that supply Student Data Management Warehouse Applications.

The committee came up with the following requirements for the solution.

- Coordination with SIS (eSchool 4.0)
- Ability to sort and view data by district, campus, class and student
- Upload and Download Options (e.g. CSV formats)
- User Friendly - Intuitive navigation
- Ability to email reminders to various groups (e.g. e-mail teacher regarding missing data, SIT meetings, etc..)
- Report Capabilities by district, campus, class and student.
- Multiple Device compatibility
- Track interventions and progress monitoring
- References - prefer Texas based medium to large districts
- Data we collect that needs to be utilized by system:
 - Running Records
 - Fluency
 - Comprehension Checks
 - TPRI


"Ideally, a platform that would allow for quick and easy access to state and local assessment data, grades, attendance, background data--all in a system that can pull reports on various groups of students. The best system would be one that we could customize to show and input data in multiple ways and from multiple sources."

We reached out at trade shows, searched the web and asked other districts what they were using. Based on our findings, our initial review included Learnmetrics, Inc, Longleaf Solutions and Alpine Achievement Systems. Each vendor was brought in for a demonstration of their product and Q&A session. Based upon these presentations, Alpine Achievement Systems was the only vendor that met some of the committee's requests, but not all. More searching was done, and Mizuni was located

We brought Mizuni in for a presentation to the committee. A smaller portion of the committee went to Pasadena ISD in May 2016 to meet directly with the users of the Mizuni system. The committee members agreed that Mizuni was the best solution for the district and recommended we move forward.

The district's current student information system, eSchool is provided by SunGard Public Sector. After discussions regarding the district's student data management needs with SunGard, they provided Mizuni, a preferred partner, as a seamless solution to our student data management concerns. Mizuni fully integrates with eSchool and can incorporate locally created data. The Mizuni product is offered through SunGard as the attached addendum to our existing contract.

SunGard Public Sector Inc. is the sole provider of the eSchoolPLUS software. It is the recommendation of Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing and Greg Mc Intyre, Deputy Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction to purchase the Mizuni Data Warehouse and Dashboard Suite from SunGard Public Sector, Inc. in the amount of \$80,000 to be paid from 2015-2016 operating funds.
