Subject: Elementary School Boundaries effective August 2019

Agenda Item: K-1.

Background

The College Station ISD Board of Trustees held workshop meetings to review and discuss possible elementary school boundaries associated with the opening the district's tenth elementary school, River Bend, on Monday, October 1, and Monday, October 8. Public forums were held on Wednesday, October 3, and Thursday, October 4, to allow community members to provide feedback to the Board of Trustees regarding the proposed zones. In addition to the public forums, board members and district administration received feedback via email from feedback@csisd.org.

The district administration's revised recommendation shared during the October 8 workshop meeting is attached. Administration also recommends that all students entering 4th grade in 2019-20 whose attendance zones change may elect to grandfather and stay at their currently (2018-19) zoned school.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District approve the proposed elementary boundaries and grandfathering recommendation as presented to accommodate the opening of the district's tenth elementary school, River Bend, effective in August 2019.
