BACKGROUND

The consideration of new courses at the high school and middle school level is the result of House Bill 3 and input focused upon meeting student needs and interests.

As in the past, Board approval allows the district the opportunity to offer the courses to see how many students are interested in signing-up for them; whether a course "makes" is dependent upon such variables as student enrollment, teacher certification, and teacher availability.

The high school and middle school courses (attached) were unanimously approved by the District Education Improvement Council for student consideration in College Station ISD.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the College Station Board of Trustees approve the new high school and middle school courses beginning with the 2021-2022 school year as presented.
