Subject: CPR Instruction Requirements Waiver

BACKGROUND

Texas Education Code, §28.0023 and applicable rules in 19 Texas Administrative Code, §74.38 require school districts to provide instruction to students in grades 7-12 in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). If graduating seniors have not completed this requirement, districts may submit a waiver of the requirement from the Commissioner of Education.

Due to the impact of COVID-19 mitigation measures in place throughout the 2020-21 school year, CSISD will be unable to fully complete requirements for current seniors to complete instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for the current school year.

The District Educational Improvement Council (DEIC) participated in an electronic vote, and by majority rule approved the submission of this waiver prior to board action.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the College Station ISD Board of Trustees approve College Station ISD's submission of the CPR Instruction Requirement Waiver for seniors in the 2020-21 school year to the Texas Education Agency.
