BACKGROUND

In the spring of 2019, our district began conversations with Bryan ISD to expand opportunities for our students to participate in Career and Technical Programming we cannot accommodate in our district due to facility and resource constraints. The Board approved this partnership which has been beneficial for our students.

Through participation in this partnership, our students are able to learn and pursue certifications in the following areas:

1. Automotive Technology
2. Industrial Engineering and Robotics
3. Welding Technology
4. Construction Technology (this particular area would only be available for our students if we could not accommodate our students at College Station High School due to class sizes and/or demand)

We are requesting to renew our partnership with the Bryan Career and Technical Education Complex to ensure our juniors and seniors have every opportunity to graduate high school with a career skill that could help them work their way through college or be a viable career upon graduation from high school.
