AMENDMENT

The original order is being amended to correct the information for Vote Center number 10, Brazos County Elections Administration Building, 300 E. Wm. J. Bryan Pkwy. Ste. 100, Bryan, Texas and to remove vote center number 21, Christ United Methodist Church, which is unavailable due to construction.

BACKGROUND

Texas law mandates that school districts be governed by a specific number of public officers elected by voters from the school district. The College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees serve staggered, three year terms. Each of these positions on the Board are At-Large, meaning that any voter residing within the boundaries of the school district, who is otherwise eligible to vote, may vote for any candidate running for school board trustee. Similarly, any candidate residing within the boundaries of the school district who otherwise meets the qualifications to run for office and serve as a public official, may run for a place on the board.

This amended order calls for the general election for At Large Position 1 and At Large Position 2 on the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees on November 2, 2021. The attached Order of General Election provides the statutory notice that is required to be published for any election held in the State of Texas.

RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that the College Station Independent School District approve the Amended Order of General Election regarding the November 2, 2021 general election.
