1. Consideration, discussion and possible action related to stipends for Special Education positions in the 2023-24 school year

Deputy Superintendent/CAO Molley Perry introduced Chief Financial Officer Amy Drozd, who <u>reviewed</u> the five year Special Education enrollment history, the shortage of Special Education staff across the state, and the proposed stipends for Special Education positions in CSISD for the 2023-24 school year. It was recommended that the CSISD Board of Trustees adopt the following stipend schedule for special education staff for the 2023-24 school year:

ARD Facilitator	\$2,500
Bilingual Assessment Staff	\$5,000
Diagnostician	\$6,000
Lead (Diagnostician, LSSP, Speech)	\$2,500
LSSP	\$6,000
Speech Language Path, Assistant	\$3,000
Speech Language Path, CCC	\$5,000
*SPED Teacher - Specialized Programs (AB, CASL, ECSE, LIFE, etc.)	\$4,000
*SPED Teacher - Other (Resource, Co-Teach)	\$1,500

<sup>\*</sup>denotes new stipends for 2023-24

For clarification, a stipend is an additional fixed amount that supplements the base teacher salary for special duties and responsibilities or licenses that would be above and beyond that base teacher pay that do not change with pay grade changes. The comprehensive employee stipend plan for next year will be presented at the regularly scheduled June meeting.
