## B. DECLARATION OF QUORUM / WELCOME

President Horak declared a quorum with five members present. In attendance were President Jeff Horak, Vice President Darin Paine, Trustee Kim Ege, Trustee Kimberly McAdams and Heather Simmen. Trustee Blaine Decker was not in attendance. Secretary Joshua Benn arrived at 12:24 pm.

Dr. Tim Harkrider, Superintendent, reviewed the Board Resolution in Support of a Fair and Transparent Accountability System in regard to the lawsuit against the State. This is just a discussion item today and will be brought back to the board for possible action at the February 20, 2024 board meeting.

2. Consideration and discussion regarding the Reconvened CSISD Long Range Facility and Bond Planning Committee recommendations

Austin Dunson, Director of Communications, <u>reviewed</u> the board's decision to reconvene the CSISD Long Range Facility and Bond Planning Committee to review the results of the November 2023 election and determine the next steps for the district as a result of proposition C and D not passing. Committee representatives Rick Bennett and Paul Hawryluk reviewed the recommendations made as a result

of discussions held by the committee on January 17th and January 24th. It is the recommendation of the committee that the board call bond election on May 4, 2024. Calling the bond was unanimous by the committee. All but one member recommended the election to be held in May of 2024. One member recommended waiting until the November 2024 election date. Clarifying questions were asked and answered. Discussion occurred.
