BACKGROUND

The District Education Improvement Council (DEIC) has the responsibility of recommending the goals for the District Improvement Plan (DIP) to the Board of Trustees each year. The DEIC also monitors the DIP three times per year to provide feedback on the action steps and progress. The DEIC met on March 4, 2026 to review the progress on the District Improvement Plan and relevant strategies and data. Based on the information presented, the DEIC voted to continue utilizing the six goals of the CSISD Strategic Plan for the 2026-2027 District Improvement Plan:

- Goal 1: CSISD will enhance effective instructional practices by implementing innovative and personalized learning experiences.

- Goal 2: CSISD will elevate academic outcomes of historically underperforming student groups.

- Goal 3: CSISD will enrich students' school experiences by strengthening relationships between students, staff, and families.

- Goal 4: CSISD will cultivate and strengthen intentional partnerships with local businesses, community organizations, and higher education agencies.

- Goal 5: CSISD will improve the technology ecosystem by increasing access to devices, strengthening technology infrastructure, and ensuring a safe and secure digital environment.



Goal 6: CSISD will transform the learner experience through purposeful integration of instructional technology to augment the teaching and learning process.

RECOMMENDATION
